

# Recital Volunteers

Dance parents and families,

There is a few weeks until our recital kicks off, and we couldn't be more excited to share with you what we have been working on all year! Your dancers have been working hard and should feel very proud of what they've accomplished and worked towards! In order for our recital weekend to run smoothly, we are in need of many volunteers to fulfill various roles on recital day. Everything from class supervisors to flower sales -- we need your help! Some people choose to volunteer at a recital that their dancer is not in, and others choose to volunteer at a recital that they already plan to attend. *Please see the descriptions below to see if there is volunteer role that you or a family member could fulfill...* we thank you for your consideration!

## **Class Supervisors**

This is our biggest need! Supervisors wait backstage in their class' dressing room during the show, and will get to stand right next to the stage and watch their class perform from the wings!

Time commitment: attend a short informational meeting at the dance office on Wednesday, May 30th at 5:30pm. Class Supervisors must attend both the dress rehearsal and recital associated with their class.

## **Lobby Sales**

Time commitment: 30 minutes before recital, 15 minute intermission.

Type: Concessions, Flower sales, Registration Table

Note: you will still be able to watch the entire show! This is a fast paced volunteer opportunity with minimal time commitment. A great option for dads, older siblings, or whole families to volunteer together!

## **Ushers & Greeters**

-*Greeters* will pass out programs and welcome our guests before the show. Your duties are done as soon as the show begins, and you can return to your purchased seat.

Time commitment: 30 mins before the show.

Note: Ages 8+ can volunteer with a parent or other adult. This is a simple but important part of our show!

-*Ushers* will help guests find their seats, direct to restrooms, etc. Usually, the usher's job duties are minimal after the show begins, but you will be "on call" in case a guest needs help. This is our only volunteer slot that comes with a free ticket (contact Mary for free ticket code after you sign up for your volunteer slot!).
